Is Angola lagging behind in the development of telecommunications?

Compared to the United States, Angola is massively lagging behind in the development of telecommunications. Under the country code +244, there were a total of 25.83 million connections in 2024. Among them were 25.74 million mobile phones, which corresponds to an average of 0.70 per person. In the US, this figure is 1.1 mobile phones per person.

Does Angola have a satellite program?

Angola has invested in its own satellite program and is also looking to global satellite providers to supplement coverage. Angosat-2 - Angola's communications satellite: In October 2022, Angola launched Angosat-2, a geostationary communications satellite, into orbit.

How do satellite networks work in Angola?

While terrestrial networks (fiber, towers) spread outward from urban centers, satellites can leapfrog infrastructure to deliver links directly to far-flung communities. Angola has invested in its own satellite program and is also looking to global satellite providers to supplement coverage.

How many mobile network operators are there in Angola?

Angola has three mobile network operators (MNOs): Unitel, Movitel, and Africell. Unitel - launched in 2001 - is the market leader and historically held a near-monopoly on mobile internet. Movitel, which started as a state-owned mobile division, became the second operator.
