Here's the kicker: Thicker glass doesn't always mean better. The 2023 NREL study found that 4mm glass only improves hail resistance by 12% compared to 3.2mm, while adding 18% more weight.

2024's breakthrough in micro-textured glass surfaces allowed 2.8mm glass to match 3.2mm performance in lab tests . But real-world durability concerns keep most producers in the 3.0-3.2mm ...

For instance, the transition from 3.2mm to 2.8mm for single-glass modules and 2mm for double-glass modules, and even to 1.6mm, necessitates a careful consideration of the glass treatment.

“A fully double glass-based PV production will require amounts of float-glass exceeding today's overall annual glass production of 84 Mtas early as 2034 for Scenario 2 and in 2074 for Scenario 1,” they said.
