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Who is Ontario Power Generation?

There has never been a more exciting time to be in the electricity business, and Ontario Power Generation (OPG) stands at the forefront. We are not just Ontario's top producer of clean electricity. OPG and our subsidiaries are leading the clean energy transition, from batteries and storage, to hydro, small modular reactors, hydrogen, and more.

How much energy does the city of Ottawa use?

The City of Ottawa's energy portfolio consists of over 1,800 electricity and natural gas accounts across over 1,000 facilities and outdoor lighting sites, amounting to approximately 310 million kWh of electricity and 19.4 million m³ of natural gas consumption in 2023.

What is the Ottawa cogeneration plant?

The Ottawa Cogeneration Plant is a 74 MW combined cycle cogeneration facility, powered by a single LM 6000 PC gas turbine and a steam turbine. The plant has a long-term contract to supply steam, hot water, and chilled water to member institutions of the Ottawa Health Sciences Centre.

Does Hydro Ottawa have a green energy strategy?

Environmental sustainability is a central focus at the generation stage. For our part, Hydro Ottawa, through its affiliate Portate Power, has 131 megawatts (MW) of installed green generation, which is enough clean energy to power 110,000 homes annually (or one third of the city of Ottawa).

This green generation infrastructure consists of 18 run-of-the-river hydroelectric facilities in Ontario, Quebec and New York State, 16 large solar installations, and two landfill gas-to-energy plants.
