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Does Senegal have solar power?

Fortunately, Senegal has a high potential for solar energy, enjoying around 3,000 hours of sunlight annually. In 2023, solar power made up 47.4 percent of the country's renewable energy portfolio, followed by hydro and wind power.

Will Senegal achieve 100 mw of solar power by 2030?

In Senegal, the country is set to achieve an additional installed capacity of 100 MW of solar, 100 MW of wind, 50 MW of biomass, and 50 MW of Concentrated Solar Power (CSP) by 2030.
