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Does a microATX PC case have a power supply?

Most MicroATX PC cases use either full ATX or SFX mounting patterns for the PSU area, and other compact PC cases (such as Mini-ITX models) that might use rarer sizes (such as TFX or custom, proprietary form factors) usually come with any such uncommon kind of power supply pre-installed.

Which case should I use if I have a TFX power supply?

For ATX power supplies, you can use Full Tower, Mid Tower, and Mini Tower PC cases. If you have an SFX power supply, you can use Mini Tower and Small Form Factor (SFF) PC cases. But if you have a TFX power supply, you should use SFF PC cases.

Will SFX power supplies fit in PC case?

On the flip side, SFX Power Supplies work well with Mini Tower and Small form factor PC cases. On the other hand, TFX and Flex ATX Power Supplies are only suitable for the Small Form Factor PC cases. Do ATX power supplies work with PC cases?
